German: Weltanschauung

The fundamental cognitive orientation of an individual or society encompassing the entirety of the individual or society's knowledge and point of view.




THE PEERS TEST

A Biblical worldview assessment program designed to assess how one views <u>God, man</u> and the <u>world</u> around him.





Instrument Validation

(Necessary for use at college level)

- 1- Construct Validity
- 2- Item Discrimination Analysis
- 3- Professional Validity and Reliability Examination

What the PEERS Test is not-

Test of Bible knowledge (people, places, events)

A gauge of whether or not you are a Christian

A measure of how holy you are, or

How much you love Jesus


